Veena Lothe announces policy platform to combat the gun violence epidemic in Virginia

GLEN ALLEN, VA — Veena Lothe released her policy platform to combat the gun violence epidemic in our Commonwealth this morning. Lothe is the only candidate in the 12th District State Senate race who has released a comprehensive plan to tackle gun violence.

"In this past year, Virginia has experienced over 500 incidents of gun violence throughout the Commonwealth, which disproportionately affected children, police officers, and communities of color," said Lothe. I am running to combat this issue head on through bold reforms to make our Commonwealth a safe place for all."
